

Fareham & Gosport Challenge & Adventure

Rules for the young people

At the first meeting of the group, on 13 June 1996, the following group rules were agreed, and still apply :

1. No offending while on the Scheme - anyone who offends will automatically be excluded from the Scheme, (“offending” means being convicted or cautioned for a criminal offence).
2. Full attendance at Scheme events (unless ill and you have telephoned the Challenge & Adventure number to give prior warning).
3. Good attendance at School (if you currently have a School to attend).
4. Keep to the Scheme’s rules (i.e. the rules on this page).
5. No smoking (Hampshire County Council have imposed a no smoking rule at Brune Park Community School, so that smoking is not allowed anywhere on the School site. Smoking is also not allowed on any minibus that the group may use. In addition, we must keep to any no smoking rule that may apply at any place that the group visits.)
6. No swearing.
7. Taking turns at talking in the group (we must try to be polite and listen to each other).
8. Time keeping (members must be on time for group events, especially when a visit is involved which may mean using a minibus).
9. No fighting.

If a group member breaks the first of these rules, they will not be allowed to continue to be a member.

If a group member breaks any of the other rules, then the group (and / or the organisers of the group) may decide that they will be excluded from the Scheme.
